Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild public education, the 2024-25 Budget is delivering record education funding, including \$1.4 billion for new and upgraded schools in regional NSW. This targeted investment will ensure growing communities get access to a world class public education.

As part of this investment a project is underway to build a new education campus in Jindabyne. The purpose-built campus will include a primary school and high school, known as Jindabyne Public School and Jindabyne High School, as well as a public preschool, with modern facilities to support students, teachers, and the community.

Progress update

Works have been progressing well and the primary and high school builds are nearing completion. Over the last few months these works have been completed:

- internal road works including line marking
- perimeter fencing works and hard landscaping
- irrigation system on sports fields
- all defects rectified in completed buildings.

Works are continuing to finish the primary school and high school. These works include:

- completion of joinery installation
- line marking on school sports courts and landscaping
- furnishings and equipment to be delivered and installed
- installation of all information and communication technology (ICT)
- wayfinding signage.

SSD Modification 2 on exhibition

We have recently submitted a modification request to the Department of Planning, Housing and Infrastructure. The modification relates to various amendments to improve the operations of the schools.

The exhibition period for Modification 2 (SSD-15788005-Mod-2) is from Wednesday 18 September 2024 until Tuesday 1 October 2024.

Installation of high voltage connection to campus

We have recently had our high voltage connection to the new Education Campus site approved by Essential Energy, and work will be starting in the coming months. We will update the community when this work starts.

Barry Way roadworks

Works have started on Barry Way to provide safe access for students, staff and vehicles traveling to, near and within the Jindabyne Education Campus. The purpose of this work is to:

- create a new intersection on the northern side of the school site
- create a new roundabout on the southern side of the school site
- reduce the speed limit along Barry Way adjacent to the school from 100km/hr to 80km/hr
- include a school zone that will reduce speed to 40km/hr in school times.

Snowy Monaro Regional Council has approved the section 138 applications for the intersection works on the northern side. We are currently waiting for the section 138 approval for the roundabout works on the southern side.

We ask that vehicles travelling along Barry Way adhere to speed limits while these works continue to take place.

Additional works are planned, subject to approval, and will be shared in the next update.
